



2017 CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules and regulations apply to the camping areas to the east of the main entrance road off of Highway 54 as well as the main campground located to the east of the dirt track pit area. No overnight camping is allowed in any of the regularly designated parking areas. Reserved space becomes available on Monday of the week that the event falls within.

Pricing: All reserved camping spots must be paid in advance. "No Refunds"

Reserved Power Spots - \$35/Night

Reserved Dry Camping Spots - \$20/Night

Dry Camping Spots - \$10/Night

- 1. ALL CAMPERS MUST CHECK IN WITH THE CAMP OFFICE OR AT MAIN OFFICE PRIOR TO PARKING - NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 2. ALL CAMPERS WILL BE ISSUED A CAMPING PERMIT THAT MUST BE DISPLAYED IN VEHICLE AT ALL TIMES.**
- 3. Quiet time hours are from 1:30am – 6:30am**
- Camping fee is for one camping unit per spot.
- Camping fee's start the day unit/s is placed on Lucas Oil Speedway Property.
- All golf carts/atv's on Lucas Oil Property must prominently display an official 2017 Lucas Oil Speedway golf cart/atv permit on the left front of unit at all times.
- Golf cart/atv and driver must be present to receive a permit from Security/Camp ground office.
- Golf carts/atv's are not permitted during "quiet times" as designated by Lucas Oil Speedway Officials. Complete golf cart regulations and permit information is available at camping office or on the website: www.LucasOilSpeedway.com.
- Golf carts/atv's are restricted to the designated roads and paths within the camp ground area and parking lots of Lucas Oil Speedway. Violation of restricted areas will result in loss of privileges.
- 10. Maximum Speed Limit is 7 MPH** (includes all vehicles, golf carts & atv's)
- Drones and Fireworks are prohibited and users are punishable by all Federal and State Laws.
- Excessively loud generators may be subject to "quiet time" hours of 1:30am-6:30am.
- Loud music and/or excessive partying outside of designated "quiet time" hours (1:30am-6:30am) will result in loss of camping privileges, with no refund.
- Music must be kept to a low level along with all other noise rendering devices. We are not discouraging the enjoyment of others as you sit around campfire and enjoy a night of relaxation and fun but we must be mindful of others around you.
- All pets are to be leashed and under your control at all times - please clean up afterthem. (No Pets allowed in Grandstands).
- Trash is to be bagged daily and placed in front of your space for pickup - please don't place bags in barrels.
- Space is to be cleaned upon departure and all trash bagged. Failure to comply will result in loss of future privileges.
- Campfires must be distinguished upon departure. Failure to comply will result in loss of future privileges.
- Shower and Bathroom Facilities are available to all campers. Please be courteous to keep facility clean and keep toilets clear. Do not put any paper towel or other debris in toilets.
- Pump out service will be available at select events for a nominal fee by BWI Sanitation. Absolutely NO DUMPING on ground of any kind. BWI Sanitation phone number: (417) 869-6666
- Fresh water will be available at select events for a nominal fee by BWISanitation.
- Failure to comply with any or all of these rules will result in loss of privilege.
