Introduction

I-10 Race Promotions, Inc. d/b/a Lucas Oil Speedway ("**Company**") respects your privacy and are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy.

This policy describes the types of information that we (including via our related company Lucas Oil Products, Inc. and contracted Website developer and operator Cavaho, L.L.C. d/b/a MyRacePass) ("**We**" or "**Us**") may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the website https://www.lucasoilspeedway.com/ (our "**Website**") and our collective practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This policy applies to information we collect:

- On this Website.
- In email, text, and other electronic messages between you and this Website.

It does not apply to information collected by:

- Us offline or through any other means, including on any other website operated by any of Us or any third
 party (including our affiliates and subsidiaries); or
- Any third party (including our affiliates and subsidiaries),including through any application or content (including advertising or third-party ticketing sites) that may be linked to or accessible from or through the Website; or
- Any Website other than the Website (which separate websites include, without limitation, https://www.myracepass.com/ which is subject to its own separate privacy policy).

Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

We collect several types of information from and about users of our Website, including information:

- By which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal address, email address, telephone number, and any other identifier by which you may be contacted online or offline ("Personal Information"):
- That is about you but individually does not identify you, such as your IP address; and/or

 About your internet connection, the equipment you use to access our Website such as your web browser and operating system, and usage details such as web pages visited, time spent on web pages, and date and time of access.

We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.
- Automatically as you navigate through the site. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through web analytics services, cookies, web beacons, pixels, server logs, plug-ins, and other tracking technologies.

Information You Provide to Us

The information we collect on or through the Website may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our Website, such as your name, email address and phone number. This includes information provided at the time of completing our contact form or subscribing to our newsletter. We may also ask you for information when you enter a contest or promotion sponsored by us, and when you report a problem with our Website.
- Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact us.
- Your responses to surveys that we might ask you to complete for research purposes.

Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies

As you navigate through and interact with our Website, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

We may disclose aggregated information about our users, and information that does not identify any individual, without restriction.

We may disclose Personal Information that we collect or you provide as described in this privacy policy:

- To our subsidiaries, affiliates, and companies with common ownership.
- To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business.
- To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of any of our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which Personal Information held by any of us about our Website users is among the assets transferred.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your Personal Information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- To enforce or apply our terms of use and any other agreements with you.
- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of any of us, our customers, or others.
